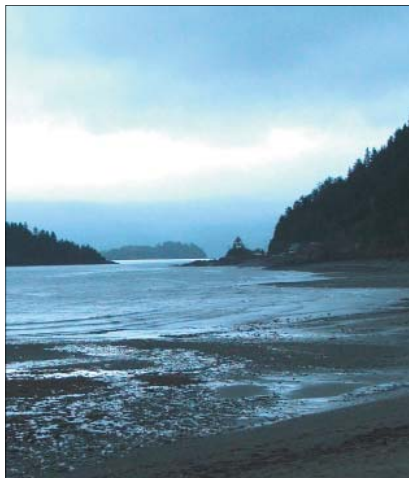
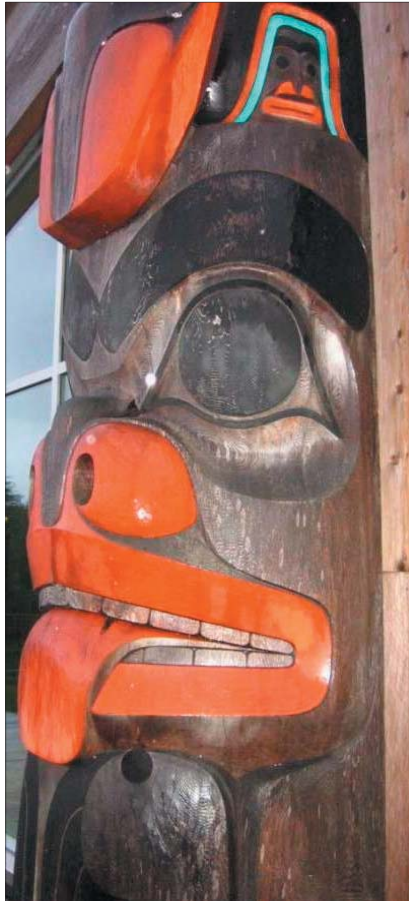


Haida Gwaii Community Electricity Plan

Expression of Interest: Standing Technical Committee



The Council of the Haida Nation and BC Hydro have commissioned the development of a Community Electricity Plan (CEP) for Haida Gwaii/Queen Charlotte Islands. The work will be carried out by the Sheltair Group, a Vancouver-based consulting firm, in association with several other firms, throughout the next year.

Standing Technical Committee

As part of this process, we are convening a Standing Technical Committee to advise the consultant team on identifying and evaluating feasible demand-side management options, electricity supply and implementation strategies.

Sheltair is looking for up to ten island residents with a background in electricity / energy to be a part of the standing technical committee.

Ideally, committee members would have:

- An understanding of energy including conservation issues, energy systems and alternative electricity supply,
- Technical experience with energy systems, and
- Experience or interest in electricity planning.

To be eligible for the Standing Technical Committee, you must be a full-time resident of Haida Gwaii/Queen Charlotte Islands and must **not** have a financial interest in an independent power producer project (IPP). Please note that input from IPPs will be considered separately as part of the community involvement process.

If you are interested in becoming a member of the Standing Technical Committee, please send a letter to the email or mailing addresses below by **February 1st, 2007** expressing your interest and detailing your experience.

Decisions on the membership of the Standing Technical Committee members will be made by the CEP Working Group, which is comprised of elected officials from all Island communities.
